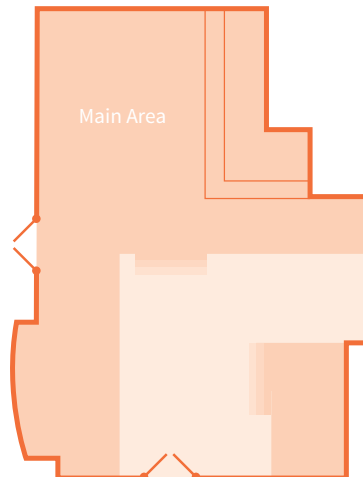


## Cabaret Bar

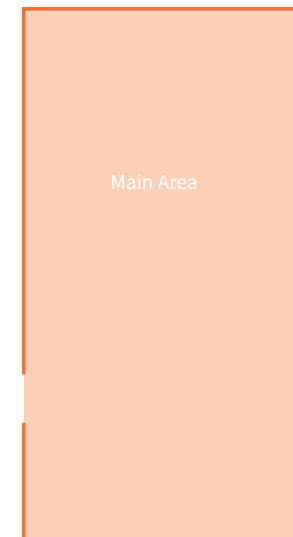
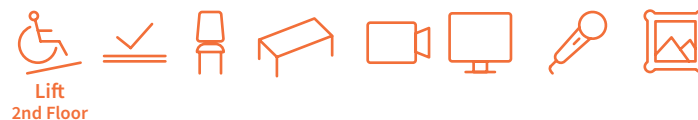


## Upper Hall

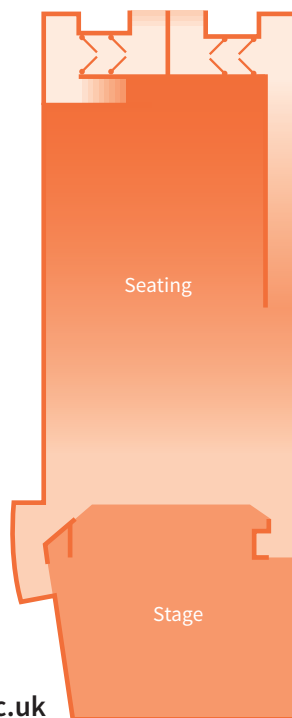

# Quaker Studio

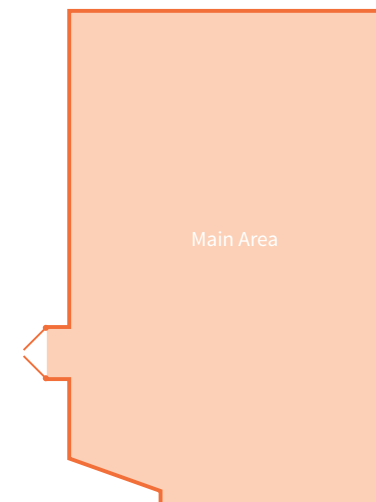
A large, impressive space with beautiful arched windows, the Quaker Studio is a flexible venue which can be used for performances or rehearsals.

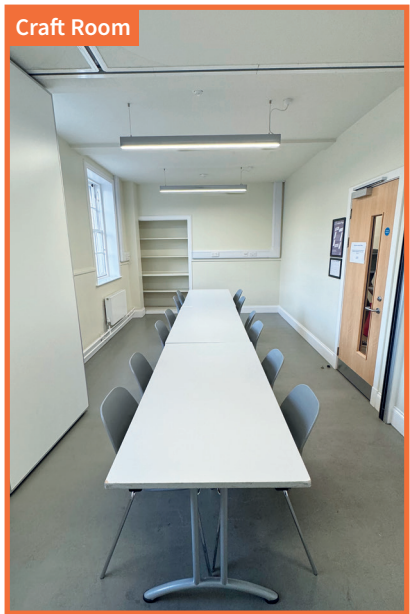

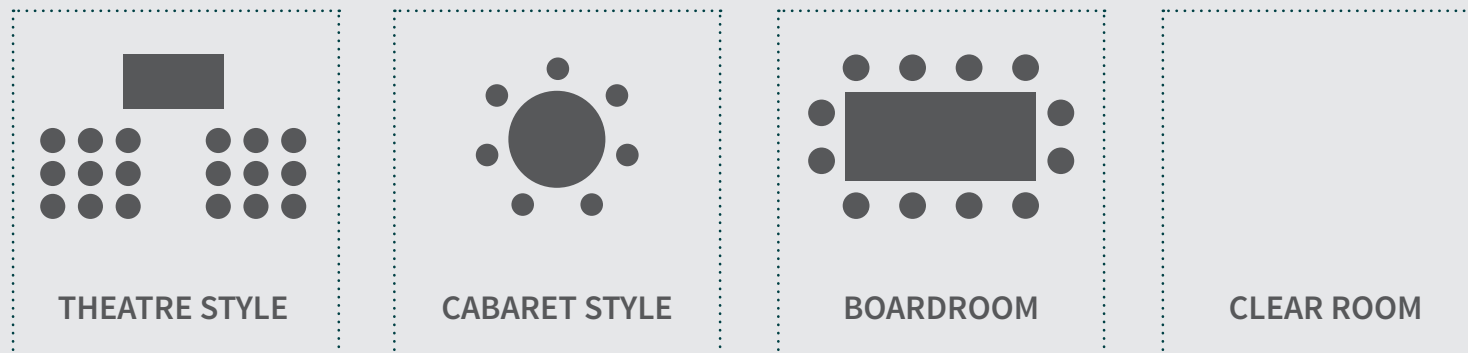

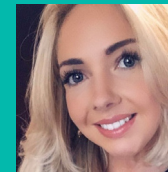
